### Arrival

Please check in at the **Business Office** (follow the signs as you drive into camp), so we can give you a cabin assignment and schedule. **If you are arriving Friday evening, please try to be here before 10:00 p.m.** If this is not possible, just give us a call and let us know so we can arrange a special cabin assignment. You will be placed in a cabin with 2 or 3 other families.\* If you would like to bunk with any family in particular, give us a call in advance. \*Families coming for Family Camp may request a private cabin.

- \* Comfortable tennis shoes, hiking boots, etc.

- \* Light rain slicker (just in case)

Some activities -- particularly riflery, archery and horseback riding -- will be organized and scheduled by our staff during the day and limited to specific times. Of course, you will be free to choose any or none of these activities and free to use the rest of the property and activities, including canoeing, kayaking, tennis, hiking trails, putting green, athletic fields, basketball court, etc. at your leisure.

Riding times will be assigned by cabin and be available at Check-In. Because of limited adult-size horses, riding will be offered to the boys only.

## Father / Son & Family Weekend Policies

It is our natural and professional tendency to try and keep people busy as much of every day as possible, so be patient when we disturb your reading and try to entice you into a basketball freethrow shooting competition. We'll be doing our best to restrain ourselves this weekend. For supervision's sake we had to organize the Riflery, Archery and Riding time, but the rest of the grounds are at your disposal as you wish. Please take advantage of the hillside trails, canoes, kayaks, tennis courts, athletic fields and waterfront. **OUR MOST IMPORTANT REQUESTS ARE THAT YOU SUPERVISE YOUR CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES, AND THAT YOU REPLACE EQUIPMENT WHERE YOU PICKED IT UP!** (Past years have left us with some broken equipment and damaged supplies from unsupervised hikers.)

### What NOT to Bring

Please do not bring skateboards, scooters, skates or rollerblades. Bicycles are permitted on marked trails. Also, do not bring airsoft guns, water guns, water balloons, BB guns, archery equipment or other things that could be considered weaponry, harm others, or damage others' property.

Choice is the "Father of Satisfaction," so the schedule is yours to plan — fast or slow, active or leisure. Jump in and have fun. You are welcome to come and go as you wish this weekend. If you are interested in antiques, the Cowboy Artists museum, golf, or other attractions we'll help you out with directions.

### A FEW SIMPLE RULES

**YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DIRECT SUPERVISION OF YOUR CHILD AT ALL TIMES.**

**Absolutely no unattended children on the waterfront!** In the spirit of a small family atmosphere, we will not be able to provide lifeguards on the waterfront. Flotation devices will be available at the waterfront and with all canoes. Please use them. Ear drops will be provided all weekend to fight swimmers' "ear grunge".

Please replace equipment where you picked it up.

Please, no alcohol.

**Please no smoking in any buildings.** If you do smoke, please retain your butts and dispose of them in the trash.

**Please come promptly to your assigned Horseback riding time** (so others do not have to wait) and **come only to published times to Riflery and Archery.** Riding will be assigned in cabin groups. There are a limited number of horses, and we want to make sure everyone who arrives at the stables has a horse reserved for them.

The rifle range will be open on Saturday afternoon and the Archery range on Sunday morning (no need to sign up).

**Please stay hydrated!** Tea, water, coffee and fresh fruit will be available in the Dining Hall most of the day. The Coke machine should also be stocked.

**Please take no food or drink into the cabins,** as this attracts ants, other insects and critters.

**Please respect our neighbors' property lines.** They begin at the fence next to the Outdoor Theater on the South and highway on the North. Also, the far side of the river is not ours.

**Be careful around any new construction** on the property.

Please Remember to stay with your son at all times, take back supplies where they belong & have a great time. We're looking forward to a GREAT WEEKEND!
