WHAT WE'RE PLAYING

One of my favorite family games to play is **Mexican Train**. It has been around for a long time and is an easy game for all of the family to play. Find the detailed rules for Mexican Train [here](#).

Brief Overview:

The goal of the game is to be the first player to lay down all of your dominoes.

You will keep track of points each round, so the player at the end of round 13 with the lowest score is the winner.

You will play Mexican train with a double 12 set of dominoes.

Whatever dominoes are left in your hand at the end of each round, you will count up the dots and record those on the scorecard.

The game starts with the double 12 domino in the middle and each round goes down in number (12, 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1, Blank).

You will draw a certain number of dominoes depending on the number of people you are playing with.

The game play is a lot like chicken foot by the means you are trying to connect pairs with your dominoes to make a train on your dominoes.

If you cannot play anywhere, then you will draw a domino from the boneyard. If you can play the domino, then play it. If you cannot play a domino, then you will put up your train to let everyone know that your domino train is free to play on.

If you cannot play on your domino train, then you can either play on the community domino train or on someone else's domino train if they cannot play on their domino train.

If someone plays a double, then you must complete the double before moving on to play on your own domino train.
