CAMP LA JUNTA DOIL #28 THE PALOMAR KNOT

Many fishermen believe that the Palomar Knot is single best fishing knot and comes close to being a 100% knot when tied properly.

Knot Tying Instructions

- Double 6 inches of line and pass end of loop through eye of hook. Alternately, for small hook eyes, pass end
 of line through hook eye once, then double back and pass end of line through hook eye again from opposite
 direction, leaving about six inches of doubled line outside the hook eye.
- Tie a loose overhand knot with hook hanging from bottom.
- Holding overhand knot between thumb and forefinger, pass loop of line over the hook. Slide loop above eye of hook.
- Pull on both the standing line and tag end to tighten knot down onto eye. Clip tag end close.
