HOT WHEELS TRACK

What You Need:

- Cardboard Box
- Extra cardboard – we used a tri-fold display board that had already been written on and used.
- Duct tape
- An X-Acto knife or utility knife
- A ruler
- Hot glue

Construction:

To make the ramp, cut down the long sides of the top from the box. You can put something under the flap to keep it strong so it doesn't bend. Tape the sides down so they lay flat and flush with the box.

For the lane dividers, cut strips of cardboard from the display board and covered them in duct tape. Then hot glued them to the track.

The release mechanism is super simple. Cut a slit out of each lane divider and then cut a cardboard strip to hold the cars. You can cover this with duct tape also to make it more sturdy.

Game Play:

Lift up the cardboard arm, and the cars go racing down the track! It's fun to have a fair race because you can really test which cars are the fastest.
