

WHAT WE'RE PLAYING

FISHBOWL

What you Need:

Paper Pen/Pencil Kitchen Bowl

How to Play:

Have every person fill out 3-5 slips of paper that have one thing written on them. Each thing must be either a person, a place, or a thing.

If you have 4-6 people, I would fill out 5 slips

If you have 7+, I would fill out 3 slips

Once you have filled out your slips of paper, put them into the "fishbowl"

Divide into 2 teams and situate yourself around a circle/room by going every other person being on a different team.

Team A will go first, and they will select one person to go first. They will have 30 seconds for their team to try and guess as many right answers. Only Team A can talk during that time and answer their teammate.

As Team A's 30 seconds is up, they add up how many slips of paper they guessed correctly and record that many points for the round.

Then, it's Team B's turn, and they have 30 seconds to guess from the remaining papers in the bowl.

If a team hits the 30 second mark and the clue has not yet been guessed, it goes back into the bowl.

Once all the slips of paper have been guessed, the round is complete, and they all get added back to the bowl for rounds 2 and 3.

After round 3 is complete, add up the total number of slips of paper each team has guessed correctly from each round and the team with the most points wins!

Change teams and everyone get new pieces of paper and come up with new person, place or things and start a new game!

Each Rounds Rules:

Round 1: Player can use both words and actions, without saying any words that are a part of the answer

Round 2: Player can only use actions to get their team to guess the word.

Round 3: Player can say only 1 word to get their team to guess the clue, to they must choose carefully

Make sure you are paying attention each round to find out what words are in the bowl because the last round is hard if you don't know what words are on the slips of paper.
